Progress

All students are baseline assessed one entry using Teacher Assessment and the CEM suite. Expected progress is 2 sub steps on a 1-9 scale in Secondary and 6 sub steps Primary. Teacher assessments are submitted termly following internal moderation and work scrutiny. Below are the percentages of students making at least expected progress from baseline across the key stages. This includes both dual and single registered students.

Key Stage 4 Attainment

As a personalised learning service our aim is to provide a curriculum appropriate for all young people referred to our service. The cohort for June 2015-16 was 36 students with 60 students in Year 11 across the year. 97% of students achieved formal accreditation. 58% achieved both English and Maths. 44% achieved four or more GCSEs. 5% were predicted to be NEET in September 2016.
